

NEED HELP WITH YOUR TELEPHONE or BROADBAND BILL?

Roome Telecommunications Inc announces the availability of Lifeline telephone and broadband service for qualifying low income Oregon customers. Lifeline is a GOVERNMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM this is non-transferable. This program is limited to one discount per household, consisting of either wireline, wireless, or broadband service. Oregonians who receive one of the qualifying benefits may receive up to a \$12.75 reduction in their monthly bill for local residential telephone or up to a \$9.25 reduction in their monthly bill for broadband service. Proof of eligibility may be necessary for enrollment.

The eligibility criteria for Oregon Lifeline includes the following:

- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program; Food Stamps (SNAP)
- Medicaid under Title XIX and XXI of the Social Security Act
- Federal Public Housing Assistance (section 8)
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Veterans and Survivors Pension Benefit ** NEW as of 12/2/2016

You may also qualify if your total Household income is at or below 135% of federal poverty guidelines
